Background

A-G Completion Improvement Grant Plan provides additional supports to local educational agencies (LEAs) to help increase the number of California high school pupils, particularly unduplicated pupils, who graduate from high school with A-G eligibility requirements completed for admission to the California State University and the University of California. Impact The A-G Completion Improvement Grant focus areas include professional development for staff regarding the logistics of A-G coursework and implementation of Advanced Placement courses, supplemental activities that directly support students accessing A-G courses such as Saturday sessions, intercessions during winter and spring, and

tutoring. The A-G Completion Improvement grant supplements services already provided through the Local Control Accountability Plan.

Staff provided a presentation to the OYA Governing Board at its February 24, 2022 meeting.

Fiscal Implications

The OYA will receive an estimated amount of \$151,992 to be spent during the 2022–2026 fiscal years.

Student Impact

The A-G Completion Improvement Grant funds directly impact all SCCOE high school students. These funds will be used to support professional learning for counselors, administrators and teaching staff, A-G online learning platforms, and summer school.
