

Eureka Math Curriculum Support for Grades K-5

Eureka Math is a free online mathematics program that aligns with the Common Core State Standards-Mathematics (CCSS-M). Participants will learn how the program is structured while preparing to teach the first module. Emphasis will be placed on the instructional shifts necessary to implement the program as well as assessment. Teachers will also engage in a model lesson.

Outcomes:

- Understand how the Eureka Math modules, topics and assessments promote mastery of CCSS-M standards.
- Understand how to implement the Eureka Math curriculum.
- Learn how to share information about Eureka Math with others.

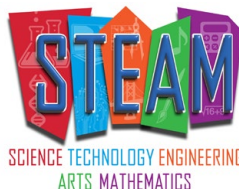
